Nearly half of Norway's land mass is Arctic territory, consisting of the two counties Nordland and the combined county of Troms and Finnmark. In this expedition you will travel from Oslo, the vibrant capital of Norway, to the islands of Senja and Tromso, possibly the best aurora borealis locations in the world because of its proximity to the Earth's Magnetic Pole,

NORTHERN LIGHTS

Watching the northern lights dancing overhead on a clear night is one of the most espectacular and awe inspiring sights of nature, and one that leaves memories that would last a lifetime.

Vikings associated the lights with Bifröst, the rainbow bridge to the realm of the gods. In AD 1230, the first rational description of this phenomenon, is found in the Norwegian Chronicle, The King's Mirror, when at the time some believed that auroras were lights in the sky coming from fires that surrounded the oceans.

Today, we know that auroras are caused by charged particles coming from the sun, that are captured by the Earth's magnetic field and guided down towards de polar regions, where they collide with atoms in the atmosphere that again sends out light in amazing colors.




UNFORGETTABLE SENJA

FROM SEA TO SUMMIT



Tromsø, a city of mountains, fjords and fauna, has been known as the "Paris of the North" because of its rich culture, intellectual life and current fashions.


